Conqueror Spraying Oil

Yates Product of the Month for June 2010 is the new-look **Yates Conqueror Spraying Oil**.

Conqueror Spraying Oil has long been popular because of its effectiveness, its versatility and its low toxicity. Conqueror Oil has a physical action – it coats pests with a film that literally suffocates them. This makes Conqueror Oil effective for controlling difficult-to-treat pests like scale insects, and also means that the pests are unlikely to develop resistance to the oil. Mixing rates can be varied, too, to suit different plant types and the time of year.

Registrations have been expanded for Yates Conqueror Spraying Oil so that this low toxic oil can now be used to control aphids on apples, pears and stone fruit.

Yates Conqueror Spraying Oil has also been approved for application to citrus for control of scale insects, aphids, citrus red mite and thrips. Best of all, when Conqueror Oil is applied to fruit trees there's no withholding period – fruit can be eaten the same day.

Of course, Conqueror Spraying Oil still plays a useful role in taking care of a range of pests (now including aphids) on ornamental plants like roses, and a weak dilution of Conqueror Spraying Oil (5mL per 1 cup of water) on a soft cloth makes an excellent leaf polish for smooth-foliaged indoor plants.
